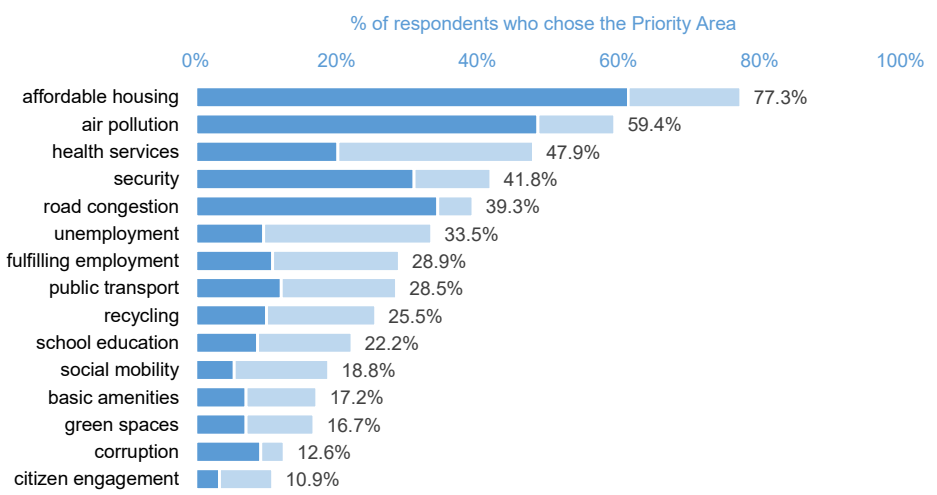

PRIORITY AREAS

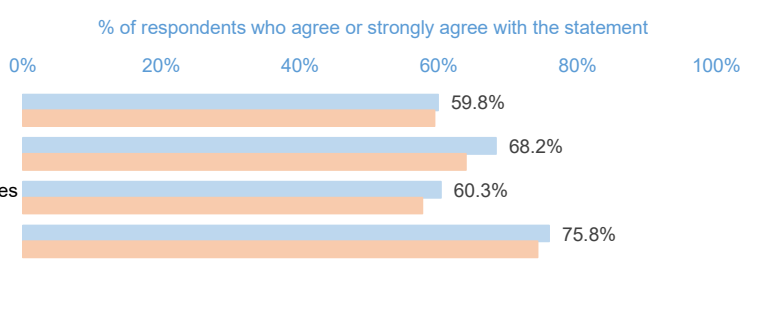

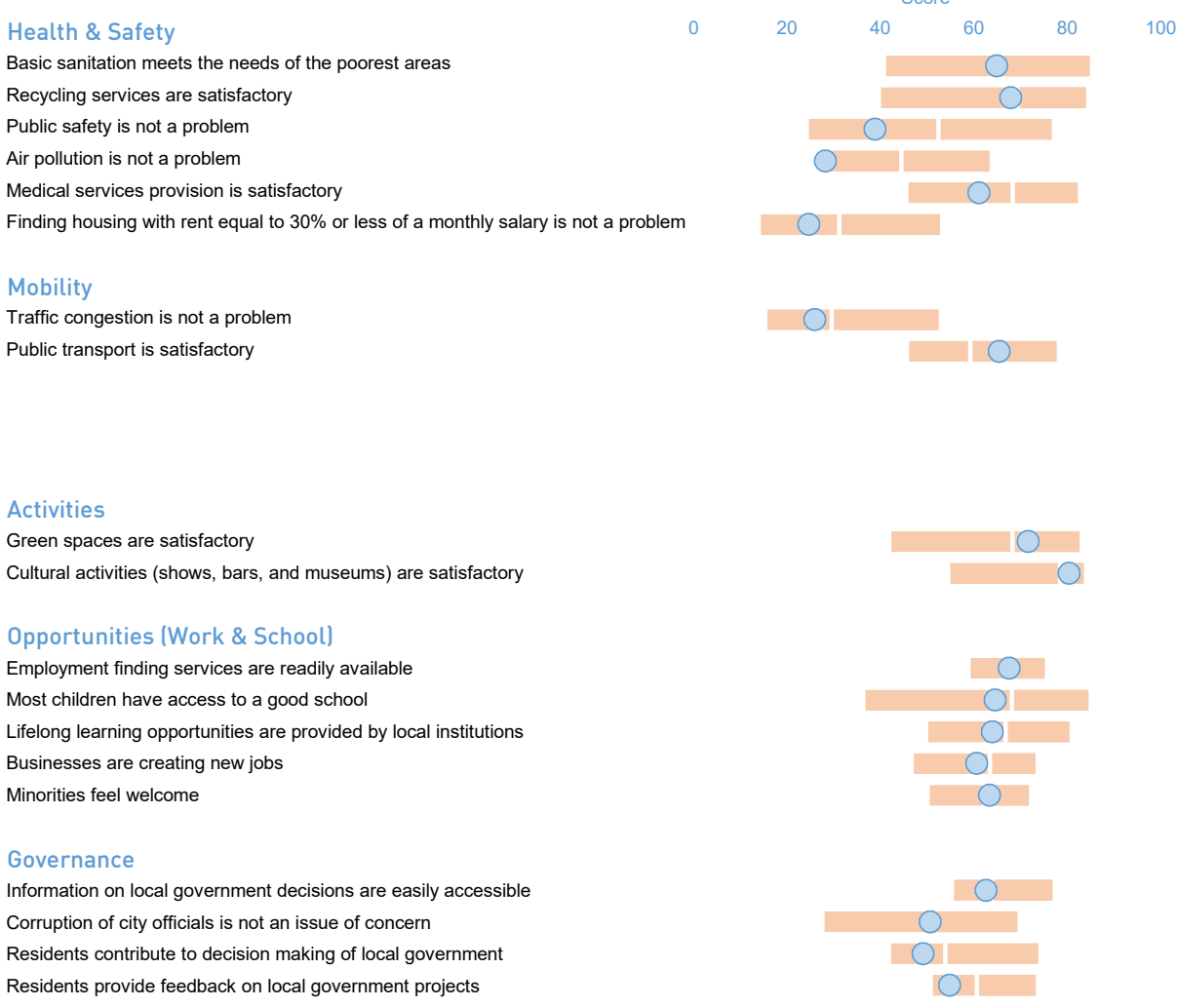
